### I. Adobe Premiere Elements - The Workspace

There are three locations to be aware of with Adobe Elements

The Player Window shows the current asset that is under the Scrubber or an asset that has been double clicked on in the Album

The Timeline / Scene line Area - shows assets that are currently being used in the project.

Tasks to do when beginning a project:

- Change the height of the timeline to reveal more or fewer tracks.
- Change the time scale that is used on the timeline to show more or less detail.
- Delete empty tracks on the timeline so only tracks used are being shown.

### 2. Elements - Loading and Organizing Assets in the Album

- Click the Organize Tab, Get Media, PC Files and Folders
- Browse to location on hard drive and select assets wanted

Organize assets in the album

- Click on the Organize Tab at the top and select Tagging
- Use the Filter Option at top left - to filter on Video Sound or Images

A second way to organize assets in the Album, Open Tagging Window

- right-click on an image and show details
- Click on a number of stars below each asset based on how you want to group them,
- Close the tagging window when done

In the album select that number of stars and the only option – only assets having that number of stars will now be visible.

### 3a. Elements – Making a Project Using Images, Videos and the Instant Movie Feature

Change scale for timeline to show 30 seconds, delete empty tracks,

Drag image to timeline that is to appear with the movie title.

Click on the Text tool (The words add text will appear on image) – drag timeline to bottom of the screen and select the animation effect wanted for text, drag text animation selection over “Add Text” in Player Window

Click on “Add Text” in Player Window and type title wanted.

To create an animation effect for image after title, Drag 2nd image to the timeline, right click on that image and show properties, show key frames and add animation to image.

Drag two video clips to timeline, crop as needed (See video on website for details)

Create instant movie for ending (The Instant movie feature will create a photo or video montage with music based on the predefined theme selected) - crop as needed, add sound to intro, add transitions between scenes and Share Movie.

### **3b. Elements - Creating an Instant Movie (Simplest Movie Making Option)**

- Use tagging option to easily see all pictures in the album. Select pictures wanted by giving those images a certain number of stars. Close the tagging option. Show assets wanted in the album by identifying the number of stars you want to filter by and selecting only.
- Pick all images now visible and click on the instant movie tab at the top,
- Pick the type of movie you want to create from instant movie themes (to preview what movies will look like, click on one of the show options and you will get a preview of that show type) when you find the movie theme you like, click on it and click Next,
- Edit the opening title and the closing title.
- Click music and use the default music
- Click on the duration tab and click use all clips, this will cause the movie to only be as long as the number of images would make it, instead of the length being determined by the song length. (Usually 4 or 5 minutes)

### **4. Elements - Sharing a Project as a Movie for the Internet**

- Click the Sharing Tab, Click on Personal Computer, Select Windows Media format or Quick Time format for posting your video file to the web. Select a location for the video file to be saved in, Click Save and Done

### **5. Uploading a Video File after it has been created for Posting to YouTube**

Logon with your YouTube account, Click Upload, Browse to video file you shared in Adobe Elements and click Upload, Click Embed tab and Copy Code.

### **6. Embedding Code for a Video File uploaded to YouTube on a School World Web Page**

Open the School World webpage you want to embed video on

Click the Media Icon at the top and paste the code from YouTube or Google Docs at that place.

### **7. Embedding Video on a Dreamweaver Web Page**

Open the web page to post movie on

Switch to Code View and paste Embed Code from YouTube or Google Docs to web page.

### **8. Uploading a Video File to Google Docs and Get the Embed Code for a Web Page**

Log on to Google, select Gmail, switch to classic view, click on Document option at top of menu bar

Click the upload button, click files, browse to file, double click on file,

Click on start upload

Share file after it is uploaded and close movie window. Open movie window after file has been shared and copy embed link.
